Agency and Police Interviews

The Director shall respond to requests by agency officials or police officers to interview students at school through procedures that: (1) recognize individual student rights and privacy, (2) minimize potential disruption, (3) foster a cooperative relationship with public agencies and law enforcement, and (4) comply with State law. The Cooperative is not obligated to allow interviews of students at school by third parties except as mandated to do so by law.
